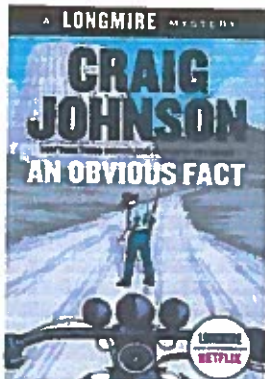
THE LADY FROM SHANGHAI (1947)
