

CARDIFF, BY THE SEA BY JOYCE CAROL OATES

"From one of the most important contemporary American writers, *Cardiff, by the Sea* is a bold, haunting collection of four previously unpublished novellas. in the titular novella, an academic in Pennsylvania discovers a terrifying trauma from her past after inheriting a house in Cardiff, Maine from someone she has never heard of. Mia, the protagonist of "Miao Dao," is a pubescent girl overcome with loneliness, who befriends a feral cat that becomes her protector from the increasingly aggressive males that surround her.

A brilliant but shy college sophomore realizes that she is pregnant in "Phantomwise: 1972." Distraught, she allows a distinguished visiting professor to take her under his wing, though it quickly becomes evident that he is interested in more than an academic mentorship. Lastly, "The Surviving Child" is Stefan, who was spared when his mother, a famous poet, killed his sister and herself. Stefan's father remarries, but his young wife is haunted by dead poet's voice dancing in the wind, an inexplicably befouled well, and a compulsive draw to the same garage that took two lives.

WHAT'S NEW AT THE LIBRARY

We are thrilled to announce Coos Bay Public Library is now fine free! This means we are no longer charging late fines on any library materials and all past overdue fines have been forgiven. The library boards of all Coastline Consortium libraries have agreed to do the same, so no items you check out from the Coos & Curry Counties library system will ever have late fines.

Even though we are now fine free, there are still firm due dates on library materials and if you don't return an item in a timely manner you will be charged the full replacement cost. Additionally, if you have an item one week overdue, you will be unable to check out anything else until that item is returned or paid for. If you want to keep using the library, you still need to return your items on time.

So, if you haven't visited the library because of old late fines, we want to welcome you back. All is forgiven! If you lost library materials and were charged for them, those fees will still be on your account. But if you can return the items, in good condition, libraries may work with you to clear your account.
