# COOS BAY PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEE MEETING MINUTES January 15, 2025

Call to Order – Chair Janice Langlinais called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m.

Janice Langlinais made a statement from the Chair regarding library usage.

**Library Foundation Report** — The Spelling Bee Committee is working on publicity and has teams interested. The Bee will be held on Saturday, 3/8/25 at Black Market Gourmet. Registration forms will be available online soon. The team cost is \$75.00. Goal setting will begin soon.

Sami suggested that the board wait until the new Library Board member is in place before choosing a replacement representative to the Library Foundation.

#### Old Business -

**Bylaw Change** – The proposed change to the City Of Coos Bay Municipal code, regarding the move to a seven member Library Board, will be presented at the next City Council meeting. After the ordinance is approved, the Library Board must observe a 30-day waiting period before making a change to the bylaws.

Handbook for Public Library Board Members – Sami reminded everyone that not all of the handbook will apply to the Coos Bay Library Board. Board members will need to complete the Public Meeting Law training. Certificates need to be sent to Sami.

#### Personal Responsibility and the Coos Bay Public Library

Personal responsibility as it relates to our public library refers to the shared obligation of individuals to not only engage respectfully with library resources, follow its policies, and contribute to maintaining a welcoming, inclusive, and productive environment for all users, but also in selecting age-appropriate materials for all members of the family.

At the same time, personal responsibility requires recognizing that libraries often offer a wide range of materials that reflect diverse perspectives and experiences. While it is important to select age-appropriate books, it is equally important to respect the autonomy of other patrons, recognizing that adults and young adults may seek more complex or challenging content. In this way, personal responsibility encompasses both safeguarding young readers and fostering a space where intellectual freedom is valued for all.

Personal responsibility also extends to selecting age-appropriate books within the library, particularly when it comes to ensuring that children and young adults access content that aligns with their developmental stages and maturity levels. Library patrons, especially parents and guardians, play a key role in guiding young readers toward materials that are suitable for their age, interests, and comprehension. This involves making thoughtful choices when selecting books, whether through the guidance of library staff or by reviewing content to assess appropriateness. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to ensure their child stays within the age-appropriate portion of the library. Unsupervised children will wander.

The library also bears a critical responsibility in supporting all age levels of patrons by curating a diverse and balanced collection of materials that meet a wide array of educational, recreational, and developmental needs. This includes ensuring that books, resources, and programs are appropriate for all age groups—offering age-appropriate selections for children, young adults, and adults, while also providing access to materials that cater to a variety of interests, backgrounds, and learning stages.

The Coos Bay Public Library does a stellar job of prioritizing the availability of books for children that foster early literacy and creativity, while also carefully considering content that aligns with developmental needs and sensitivities. For young adults, our library offers materials that promote critical thinking, emotional growth, and understanding of complex societal issues, while respecting the evolving needs of this age group. For adults, our library plays an essential role in providing access to resources that encourage lifelong learning, personal enrichment, and the pursuit of both academic and leisure reading. Staff recommendations, curated reading lists, or programs help patrons choose materials that are not only age-appropriate but also reflect diverse viewpoints, encourage intellectual curiosity, and promote cultural awareness. Our library fosters open discussions, provides context and guidance, and empowers individuals to make their own informed choices.

By fulfilling these responsibilities, the Coos Bay Public Library creates an environment where patrons of all ages can access knowledge, develop critical thinking skills, and enjoy the enrichment that comes from a broad and inclusive collection. In this way, our library plays a central role in nurturing an informed, thoughtful, and connected community, while respecting the diverse needs of every patron.

And finally, as per the <u>Library Bill of Rights</u>, our library upholds the principles of intellectual freedom and ensures that the Coos Bay Public Library remains a place where everyone has the right to access, explore, and engage with the full spectrum of human thought and creativity.

In May of 2023, Coos Bay Public Library, Oregon Health & Science University (OHSU), and twenty members of the Coos Bay community formed the Sole Mates. This partnership began a two-year research study to learn the effects of walking as a group and engaging civically to improve public health and walkability in our community. The Sole Mates decided to use funds awarded by OHSU to create a free walking guide to inspire other community members to get outside, walk, and improve their health. On January 4th the group welcomed over 100 people to the launch party to introduce the guide.

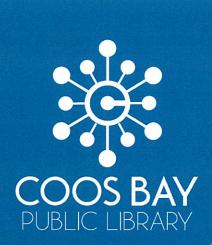

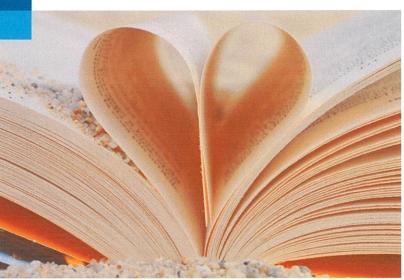

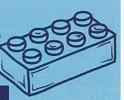
