How to Play:

A) Complete 5 squares in a row and receive a prize. Cross off each square after you read it. For each row you complete (maximum of 5 entries) you'll receive an entry into the Grand Prize Drawing. When you've finished playing, turn in your game piece to the library to redeem for prize and entry into drawing by March 1.
